  - <u>Cashier</u> making eye contact and welcoming every guest with Pure Aloha; using touch screen POS system to verify and finalize orders; collecting payment accurately and efficiently; helping to promote and facilitate "Pure Aloha Coins" giving
  - <u>Front Kitchen</u> crafting high quality shave ice, ice cream, and other food products consistently for all guests by following recipe and presentation

- standards; performing in open-kitchen to engage and entertain kids and adults while crafting products
- <u>Back Kitchen</u> completing basic and various food prep tasks; helping to replenish products and supplies for front kitchen; organizing and cleaning the area; dishwashing
